Information about these services will be uploaded to the school website and a flyer is being prepared to go out to all families. • Thanksgiving pre-paid dinners (gift cards) were donated; Mr. Doty dropped off in person. • Currently, we have a total of 63% of students who register through open enrollment. • We have a total enrollment of 930 students; our numbers dropped as they did all across TUSD. Our greatest loss was from our Senior class. • Faculty members are working at school every day. • Good news, heard about teachers to be included in the 1st round of people to get vaccinated along with first responders. • Sabino is keeping a close eye on those students who are struggling; reached out to 90 students to offer a space at school to attend. We presently have 9 students who come to school every day and learn from learning space. Cautious about enforcing safety precaution guidelines. We have been fortunate to not have to this date any positive COVID-19 cases. • Mr. Kukla (our Math Dept. Chair) is retiring at the end of this semester. He is recommending a substitute who can replace him. He will be able to co-teach with the substitute a few days a week until the end of this semester. • Athletics: football & volleyball was doing well. Band is still rehearsing. Next week, the district will review if sports will continue, including fine arts. We had a great outcome with State competitions, our golf, swimming and cross country did a phenomenal job. We had students beat their own season records! • Planning for our senior graduation. Also, working with our yearbook club and publishing company to assist with the progress and finalization of the yearbook for this school year.
